Revised Composition of District Advisory Committee on Youth Programmes(DACYP) of Nehru Yuva Kendra Sangathan

The **District Advisory Committee** on Youth Programmes of NYKS is headed by DM/DCs of respective districts and the District Youth Coordinator, NYK is the Member Secretary of this committee.

The **objective** of the DACYP is to promote youth affairs and facilitate better coordination with the concerned **District Departments and Agencies**, bridge missing links, if any, so as to generate more meaningful, relevant and need based programmes and activities for the overall development and empowerment of youth belonging to the entire cross-section of the population especially those marginalized and needy.

During the last NYKS, BOG meeting, with a view to further widen the scope of DACYP, ensure proper coordination, implementation, transparency and monitoring for effective functioning of NYKS on one hand and the expected outcome on the other hand, the **composition of DACYP has been revised**. For ready reference, a copy of the same is enclosed.

The **tenure** of non-official and nominated members shall be for a period of **one year**. For ensuring gender balance, it may kindly be ensured that 30% of the total membership of the DACYP shall as far as possible be **women**.

This issues with the approval of BOG, NYKS headed by Hon'ble Minister of State (I/C), Ministry of Youth Affairs & Sports, Govt. of India.

Functions, Frequency of Meetings, Tenure and Roles of District Advisory Committee on Youth Programmes (DACYP) of Nehru Yuva Kendra Sangathan

Functions of the Committee:

- ✓ To help the NYK in the implementation of its plans and programmes.
- ✓ To help and guide the NYK in promoting an effective youth movement in the district.
- ✓ To help the NYK in the coordination of its activities with other government and non-government departments and agencies.
- ✓ To review and evaluate the work of the NYK and suggest measures for its further improvement.

Frequency of the Meeting:

The DACYP shall meet minimum two times in a year (once in six months). The District Youth Coordinator shall inform the date of the meeting in advance and also follow-up initiatives at District Level. The minutes of the meetings of the DACYP, duly approved by the chairperson, should be sent to the Zonal Director, NYKS.

Tenure of DACYP:

DACYP is a continuous body. The term of non-official members and youth leaders will be one year from the date of nomination and National Youth Corps (NYC) volunteers will be one year (or the date on which the volunteer ship is terminated, whichever is earlier).

Roles:

1. **Chairperson of the DACYP** will preside over the meeting of DACYP and may advise and help NYKS for establishing viable linkages of NYKS with the District Administration and other Developmental Agencies for the promotion of Youth Development work in the district.
2. **District Youth Coordinator**, who is the Member secretary of the DACYP will ensure the following:
 - ✓ Should be well prepared with the profile, youth programmes, collaborating agencies and nature of youth involvement in the District.
 - ✓ Be responsible for convening the meeting of DACYP in consultation and approval of the Chairperson.
 - ✓ Prepare the agenda of the meeting of DACYP and inform Zonal Director about the agenda which he/she shall place before the committee.

- ✓ Inform the members of the DACYP, the date, time and venue of the meeting sufficiently in advance.
- ✓ Prepare the minutes of meeting of DACYP and circulate it to all concerned and also to concerned Zonal Director.
- ✓ Responsible for the implementation of the decisions of the DACYP in accordance with the guidelines and instructions of NYKS Hqrs from time to time. In case of any ambiguity he/she should refer the same to Zonal Office for further necessary action.

Pledge

I take this pledge that I will abide by the Rules and Regulations of NYKS, work with honesty, sincerity and dedication which would enable in developing and empowering youth.

I will not indulge in such behaviors or activity which may damage the image of NYKS and further will not participate or associate with groups who promote anti-social and anti-national activities.

I understand that my role would primarily be advisory in nature, therefore, I will be accountable to my deeds and will not interfere in day to day functioning of NYKS at different levels.

I assure that the funds and finances meant for NYKS programmes, establishment, etc. will not be asked for their diversion for other purpose and activities.
